The servant – by the faith of the centurion.

The ten lepers were healed as they journeyed.

Luke 17:14

Epaphroditus sick – God had mercy on him.

Phil 2:27

Some received handkerchiefs and aprons from Paul.

The blind man at first was not completely healed.

Perfect healing of the blind man.
Mark 8:25

The nobleman believed - his son began to amend from that hour.
John 4:50-52

Paul left Trophimus at Miletum sick.
